








HOW DO WE SHOW OUR CHILDREN THAT WE LOVE THEM?!

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

Your Relationship's Love Tank



- Filling your child's "love tank":
 - When they receive love in their primary love language, they feel loved. They are secure, energized and develop to their potential
 - The tank is depleted when we don't receive love; when unnoticed, attacked and with broken trust. It hurts the most with love language turned against
 - When the love tank is empty, issues arise and relationships fall apart
 - If the love tank is left empty, they will seek a "fill" elsewhere!!

1- PHYSICAL TOUCH

- Emotional power of touch since infancy (orphanage research)
- Mark 10:13-16 Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. ¹⁴ But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. ¹⁵ Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." ¹⁶ And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them.
- The form of touch changes as they grow up
- But do not withdraw from showing affection through physical touch
- A hug, a kiss, reading on your lap, as backrub, a wrestle, a race, basketball rumble!



2- WORDS OF AFFIRMATION

- Proverbs 18:21 Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
- Affirmation = acceptance of the person not the behavior or actions
- Affirmation is unconditional: not if or because
- The TONE > Words
- Affirmation comes in many "dialects"



2- WORDS OF AFFIRMATION

Words of Affection:

 Focus on who the child is not what the child does (personality, physical appearance)

Words of Praise:

- Focus on the EFFORT not the RESULT
- Beware the urge of "perfection"
- The appropriate timing of motivation

Words of Encouragement:

- Commend and enthusiasm for more
- St Paul and Timothy (2 Timothy 1:6-8)



2- WORDS OF AFFIRMATION




3- QUALITY TIME

- There is nothing more precious or irreplaceable than time you spend with your kids
- Undivided attention
- Eye Contact
- Give time that counts not the crumbs (exhausted, distracted, frustrated)




3- QUALITY TIME

- Go where they are!
 - Infants and little kids to the floor
 - Older children to the playground
 - Teenagers to the park or the gym
- Go into details!
 - Peeling the onion show interest
- Storytelling is magical!
 - They want to know you!
 - History is fascinating (especially family history!)



4- GIFTS

- In every culture gifts are an expression of love and care
- Presents are never a substitute for Presence!
- Abouna Mikhail and the pockets full of candy!!
- After every trip away from home: what did baba get me?!!
- It is the thought that counts not the price (a flower, a stone)
- Give them what they need not what they crave
 - teach them gratitude and modesty





4- GIFTS

- Everything you give-give as a gift (wrap it in love and attention): school supplies, a snack, an ironed shirt
- Gifts are NOT Rewards or PAYMENTS: they are unmerited, delivered based on GRACE
- The Fellowship and Gift of the Holy Spirit



5- ACTS OF SERVICE

- We do it from the day they are born!
 - We feed them, clean them, clothe them
- Service NOT Labor (not with grudge or anger)
- Do not do for them what they CAN do for themselves! (make the bed, laundry, clean plate...) – Age Appropriate Service
- Teach them: That is a Service!



5- ACTS OF SERVICE

- Without Obligation or Complaint:
- A Fixed bicycle but a Broken heart
- Give your child a model of service to imitate: then give them gradual opportunity to serve others



HOW TO DISCOVER YOUR CHILD'S LOVE LANGUAGE!


- Observe how the child expresses love to you and others
- Notice what they ask for the most
- Give them options to choose from
- Experiment! Pour it on and look for impact on behavior and attitude
- Recognize the impact of gender, age and stage
 - Test time
 - · Summer time
 - Child versus teenager



- Discipline = to Train (Teach + Model)
- When a child misbehaves we have choices: Permit – Punish – Discipline
- Rebellion is often an attempt to get attention: it is a pursuit of love!!!
- Always wrap Discipline in Love (The Pauline Sandwich!)



- Beware discipline by withholding the primary love language (that is harsh!) – isolation to a quality time child spanking to a physical touch child
- The purpose of discipline is correction not punishment or REVENGE!
- The Discipline must fit the crime ©
- Discipline must be positive (not only negative) reinforcement



- Discipline <u>without Anger or Aggression</u>
 (Ephesians 6:4 fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.)
- Discipline to correct (Hebrews 12:5-6 My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives."
- Prepare your child: Rules and Consequences
- Always wrapped in love (Job 5:18 For He bruises, but He binds up; He wounds, but His hands make whole.

The most effective discipline strategies are those that PROACTIVELY PREPARE a child so the parent doesn't have to REACTIVELY RESPOND

Even God Himself gets rebellious kids!!
 (Isaiah 1:2 Hear, O heavens, and give ear,
 O earth!
 For the LORD has spoken:
 "I have nourished and brought up
 children,
 And they have rebelled against Me;



 Discipline may require TOUGH LOVE (Romans 2:4-5) Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? ⁵ But in accordance with your hardness and your [a]impenitent heart you are [b] treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, ⁶ who "will render to each one according to his deeds


- When (if ever) is physical discipline appropriate?!
- Proverbs 23:13-14 Do not withhold correction from a child,
 For if you beat him with a rod, he will not die.

¹⁴ You shall beat him with a rod, And deliver his soul from hell.



WARNING

- Jesus at the Temple (Matthew 21, Mark 11, Luke 19, John 2) ONCE!!!!!
- Physical discipline has to be rare if ever (better yet: NEVER)
- Beware your anger and wrath take over
- The child must hear your love while feeling the discipline
- The mildest physical discipline can leave emotional scars and cause trauma
- Cultural and Age boundaries



LOVING YOUR TEENAGE CHILD


- The "Teenage Culture": music language dress-"attitude"
- A Difficult Development Stage
 - Seeking identity (who am I)
 - Developing Logic (WHY?)
 - Seeking Independence (differentiation)
 - Emotional instability (mood swings)
- Build Bridges not Walls:
 - Communication not Confrontation
 - Acceptance even if not Approval
 - Nurture not Nag
 - Express respect
 - Admit faults and short-comings
 - Apologize when needed

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
